Entry fees:

- The entry fees are listed at the back page of the application form. The reduced fees apply solely for ČMKU members and for the dogs registered in ČMKU studbooks.
- For distinguishing the 1st deadline and 2nd deadline payments, the date of the postal stamp on the envelope with the application form is decisive.
- The entry fee shall be transferred to the following account:

The entry fee includes a free entry for one person per every registered dog.

- The organizer reserves the right not to accept an application form without the entry fee payment. In case that the application form is accepted without the entry fee payment and the dog is entered into the catalogue, the exhibitor is bound to pay the entry fee even if he does not come to the show.
- When applying two or more dogs of the same owner, the first dog shall be the one registered to the young, intermediate, open, working or winner class. For dogs registered to baby, puppy or veteran class, fees in the amount set for these classes are payable.
- The show catalogue is included only in the entry fee for the first dog.

Classes:

- The division into the classes is in accordance with the Show Regulations of ČMKU and is shown in the application form.
- To enter a dog into the working class, the application form must be accompanied with a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate.
- To enter a dog into the winner class, one of the following titles must have been confirmed by the entry deadline: International Beauty Champion, National Beauty Champion, National Winner, Club Show Winner, Specialty Show Winner; and a copy of the title certificate must be enclosed to the application form.
- In the individual classes, first four dogs having obtained the qualification excellent or very good are placed.
- The colour varieties of some breeds are judged separately in compliance with the supplement to the Show Regulations of ČMKU.
- Owners of the dogs having obtained the title Best of Breed are obliged to take part in the final contests.

Titles:

CAJC ČR, CAC ČR, Res. CAC ČR, National Winner, Best of Breed - BOB, Best of National Breeds (BONB), Best in Group - BIG, Best of Day – BOD, Best in Show – BIS, Best Veteran, Best Couple, Best Kennel, Best Puppy Male/Female, BOD Junior, BIS Junior.

Awarding of the titles is not compulsory and cannot be claimed.

All contests:

Junior Handling is judged in two categories: I. cat. – 9 to 13 years, II. cat. – 13 to 17 years. The handler must show a dog that is entered in a stud book recognized by FCI. A dog of a junior handler does not need to be exhibited at the show. Judged is the presentation of the dog, its quality is not decisive.

Best Couple – a male and a female of the same breed and variety presented at the show, owned or co-owned by the same person(s). The co-ownership must be confirmed by a record in the pedigree.

Best Kennel – minimum three individuals of the same breed and variety, which have been judged at the show, which come from the same kennel and which have at least two

different fathers or mothers.

Best Veteran is selected from all the veteran class winners (qualification excellent 1).

Best Puppy Male/Female are selected from all puppy class winners (very promising 1).

BOD Junior is selected from all the Best Junior winners. They enter the contest according to FCI Groups.

BIS Junior is selected from BOD Junior holders.

Best of National Breeds Winner - all individuals of national breeds (český teriér, český fousek, český strakatý pes, český horský pes, pražský krysařík, československý vlčák) exhibited on the show may enter the final ring. The title is then awarded to the best individual selected from those having obtained the titles CAJC, BOB, Best veteran.

Best in Group are selected from the BOB winners from the respective FCI Group.

Best of Day is selected from the group winners.

Best in Show is selected from the dogs having obtained the Best of Day title.

Veterinary Regulations:

1. All dogs participating at the show must be clinically healthy.
2. The dogs must have antirabic vaccination in accordance with the applicable laws.
3. Dogs from the Czech Republic must be equipped with a valid vaccination record (in accordance with par. 6 of the Veterinary Act) or with a valid Pet Passport. Dogs from the EU member states must fulfil the conditions of the Regulation 998/2003/EC of May 26, 2003.
4. Dogs that did not pass the veterinary control are not allowed to participate at the show.

General regulations:

- The show is accessible to males and females of all breeds registered in FCI-recognized studbooks, which reach the age required for the entry into the class on the show day.
- Each application form must be accompanied by a copy of the pedigree, from which name of the dog, its registration number, name and address of the owner or co-owners and names of dam and sire of the dog can be recognized.
- The admission of the dog to the show will be confirmed in writing at latest ten days before the show. If the owner does not receive the confirmation in time, he should check the entry by mail or phone.
- The judging in the show is conducted in accordance with the FCI and CMKU show regulations; colour varieties are judged according to the regulations of ČMKU.
- The changes in the exterior of a dog performed by lacquering, powdering, colouring of the hair and basic treatment by trimming and long-term tying of the dogs on trimming tables are forbidden. Individuals with cropped ears are not accepted as well.
- During the show, the owners ensure that there are no injuries of dogs or persons. Free running of the dogs within the show grounds is forbidden.
- The organizer of the show is not responsible for any damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor, nor for a death or a loss of a dog.
- The dogs having obtained the BOB title are bound to participate in final contests.
- Non-participation on the show whatever the reason does not lay ground for reimbursement of the entry fee.
- The sale of the puppies within the show grounds is forbidden.

- By submitting the application form, the exhibitor agrees with publishing of his address in the show catalogue.
- By submitting the application form, the exhibitor bindingly accepts all the FCI show regulations, the ČMKU show regulations, the rules and regulations stated in this leaflet, and the instructions of the show committee.

Complaints:

A complaint against the decision of a judge is not admissible. A complaint can be lodged solely for formal reasons of breach of show regulations and propositions. The complaint must be submitted in writing, together with lodging the deposit of 1000 CZK, before the end of the show. If the complaint is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be handed over to the organiser.
